## How To Flock A Goose Decoy

**Flockit!** (dba DonJer Products) supplies both Soft Flock Rayon Fibers and Suede-Tex Nylon Fibers for flocking goose decoys.

**Suede-Tex Nylon Fibers** are better suited for the decoys because:

- ✓ Nylon is a petroleum-based fiber, therefore more durable and stands up to handling better.
- ✓ Nylon is more weather resistant because it is a synthetic fiber.
- ✓ Nylon is more colorfast so it resists fading.

One (1) 3 oz. bag of Suede-Tex Nylon fibers covers approx. 2 dozen Bigfoot decoys.

One (1) 1 lb. bag of Suede-Tex Nylon fibers covers approx. 10 dozen Bigfoot decoys.

Goose Grey and Feather Brown are only available in nylon and were color matched to goose feathers. White, Charcoal Gray, Cardinal, Mallard Green, Red and Brown are also available in nylon. Additional colors are listed on the [color chart](#).

**Suede-Tex Adhesive** is a solvent based adhesive that has been colored to match the fibers. It dries permanently and will not be affected by water.

One (1) 8 oz. can is recommended with the 3 oz. bag of fibers.

Three (3) 8 oz. cans are recommended with the 1 lb. bag of fibers.

### **Application:**

1. Prepare your decoy using a wire brush to rough up the surface so that it holds the adhesive better.
2. Mask the face cheeks.
3. Brush on a generous coating of the adhesive (brushing away from the masking).
4. Immediately apply the fibers using the **Suede-Tex Mini Flocker Applicator** to propel the fibers into the adhesive. The Mini Flocker creates a smooth, even, long-lasting finish.
5. Wait for it to dry (overnight).
6. Remove the excess fibers and reclaim them for future use.

Complete instructions for the application of the finish are included with each Mini Flocker.
